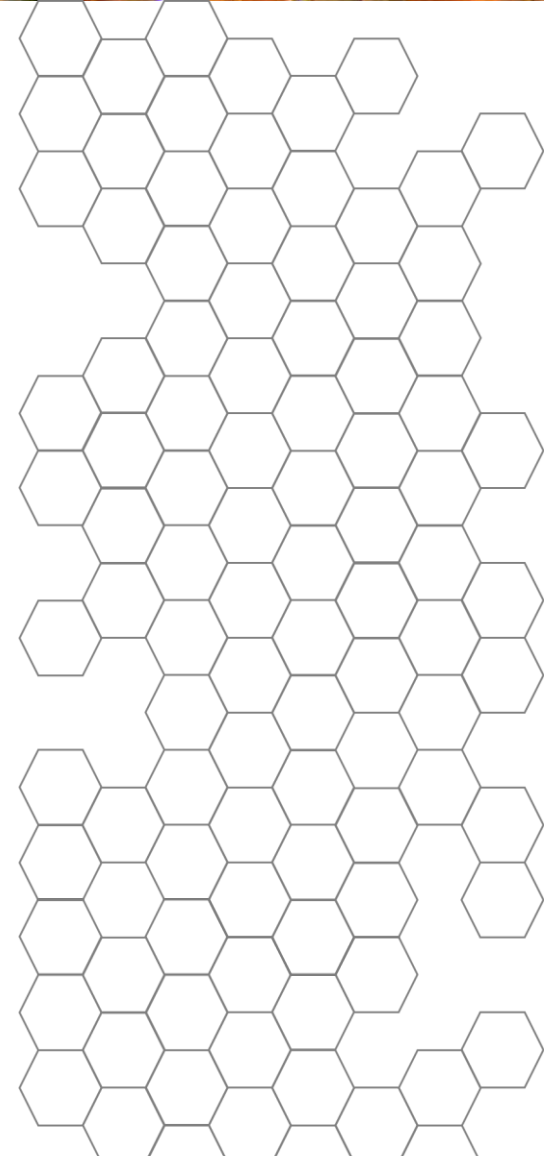

Participants per country



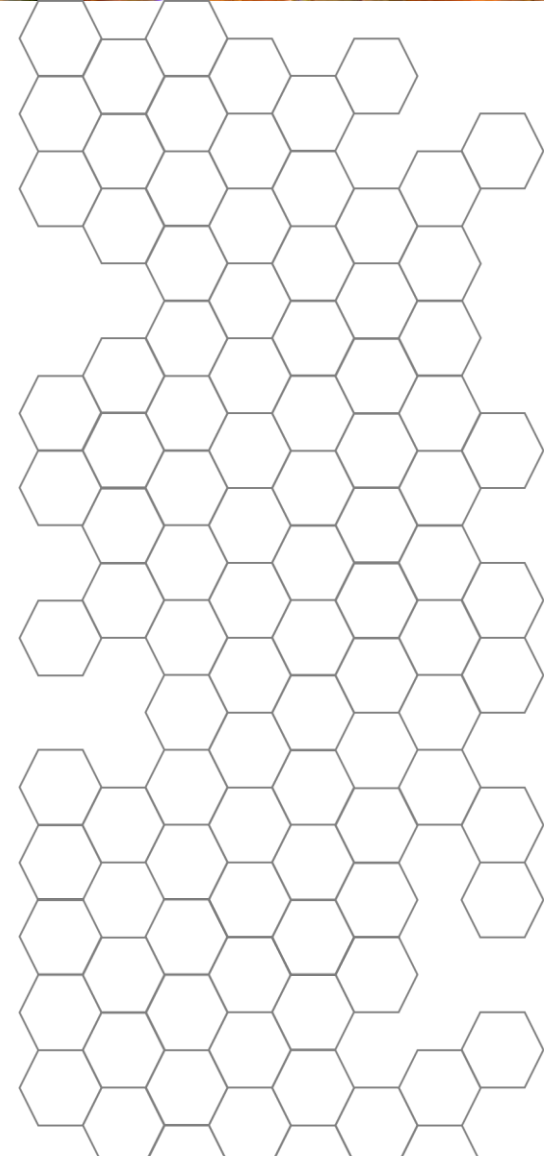
